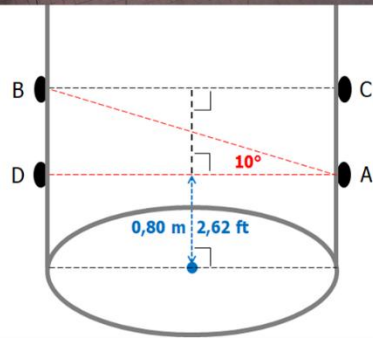
- Stage 1 - Great Britain - at Weembi Lille including the British National Championships

- Stage 3 - Belgium - at Airspace Charleroi including the Belgian National Championships
- Stage 4 – Germany/Austria - at Hurricane Factory Berlin including the German National Championships and the Austrian National Championships
- Stage 5 - Italy - at Aero Gravity Milan including the Italian National Championships
- Stage 6 - Australia - at I-Fly Sydney including the Australian National Championships
- Final Stage - France - at Zero Gravity Poitiers including the French National Championship

Seven winners / One champion

Each of the seven Stages will have their own General International Leaderboard where First, Second, and Third placed Flyers will be awarded medals and where the national anthem of the [World Series Stage's winners](#) will be played.

Each of the seven Stages will also earn points to their participants toward the World Series overall standings that will be awarded just after the Final Stage, where First, Second, and Third placed Flyers will be awarded medals and where the national anthem of the [World Series' champion](#) will be played.

All participants included / One overall standing

All participants to any of the seven Stages will be ranked in the [World Series overall standing](#) whatever the number of Stages they will have participated in.

On each Stage, the number of points awarded to participants will correspond to their places. The Firsts will score one (1) point, the Seconds two (2) points and so on.

Participants which will not have completed all Stages will be assigned for each Stage not completed the number of points corresponding to the average of the participants on all Stages, calculated after the Final Stage validation and rounded down to the nearest whole number.

Only the four lowest number of points earned by each competitor among the seven Stages will be cumulated and standing will be determined by lowest sums.

National Competitions integrated

Each of the seven Stages will also integrate their own National Competition where their own General National Leaderboard for competitors of the host country will be established.

National Competitions may have their own list of Eligible Impairments, at the discretion of each organizer, so that it might be possible to be declared eligible for a National Competition and not eligible for an International one, or vice versa.

All kind of Disabilities eligible

The eligibility to participate to any of each of the seven Stages is assessed by the IPS World Series' Classification Board during the Athlete Evaluation.

Eligibility is based on the comparison of applicants' disabilities with the list of Eligible Impairments, at least one of which must be present and meet the minimum requirement.

Eligible Impairments: See *2026 IPS World Series Rules* **ANNEX 1 article 4**
